responsible for: (1) the text book; (2) all

week's collateral reading. Fourteen such

Such reports are to be on cards 4 x 6, and are

to indicate the number of the report, the date,

the name of the author or writer read, the name

of the book or other publication, the subject

read upon, and in brief suggestive phrases, the

significant points of the matter read. (Use both

sides of cards.) Reports are to be handed in

promptly, unless delay is permitted by the

instructor for good cause. When tardiness in

handing in reports is unexcused, the student
