Il y a plus de 120 ans, le Vogesenclub (aujourd'hui Club Vosgien) a aménagé un chemin de randonnée pour traverser les Vosges, cette moyenne montagne préservée située à l'est de la France. Le GR 53 ou GR 5 décrit aujourd'hui mène par des sentiers pittoresques à travers les Vosges alsaciennes de Wissembourg à Masevaux ou Giromagny près de Belfort. Le guide de randonnée Rother ' Grande Traversée des Vosges ' présente ce chemin de grande randonnée en 36 étapes, avec quelques variantes, qui traversent les Vosges du Nord, les Vosges Moyennes et les Hautes Vosges, presque inconnues. Des étapes faciles traversant de vastes forêts et des villages endormis alternent avec des itinéraires de montagne sportifs, aux difficultés comparables à celles des Alpes à travers des paysages sauvages et préservés à plus de 1000 mètres. L'itinéraire de randonnée de 400 kilomètres de long ne suit pas le chemin le plus direct, mais toujours le plus beau. Il passe par des lieux chargés d'histoire et des châteaux forts médiévaux, ainsi que de nombreux lieux évoquant un chapitre douloureux de l'histoire franco allemande.
