He uses a lot of pronouns; the syntax is absurd; there are far too many conjunctions (y/and, que/that); the sentences are too long; he keeps repeating the adjectives; he is extraordinarily verbose, which prevents readers from understanding the book. Hence, these characteristics have deceived all

the translators. Besides, one needs to understand the author's purpose to produce a meaningful translation. Here the main character is an immature middle-aged man who has decided to live in a twilight zone where his self-respect entices him to ignore reality. Sancho, who resembles Piggy in Lord of the Flies, is a kind of impotent reason, an illiterate, penniless man who would like to make his master recover his sanity.
