In this research project, I identify and define the stenographic image and conduct a material study that seeks to track the evolution of the stenographic image in Gregg Shorthand from the 1930s until today to prove that the graphic nature of Gregg Stenography not only redeemed a new, highly criticized edition of the system in Depression Era America, but also contributed to the resilience of Gregg Shorthand in contemporary consciousness, despite the system's near-obsolete status. I summarize of key areas where Gregg Publishing Company prioritized the stenographic image and the stenographer's artistry through publication, pedagogy and system development related to the Anniversary Manual Edition of Gregg Shorthand. I focus on theoretical shorthand, the Order of Gregg Artists, and the Direct and Functional Methods. Once instances of the stenographic image are identified, I employ the writing of Hans Belting, W.J.T. Mitchell and Sybille Kramer to define and analyze the stenographic image, focusing primarily on Winifred Kenna Richmond's shorthand plates for "The Legend of Sleepy Hollow", as included in the American Readings in Gregg Shorthand. I apply an approach to image that acknowledges the perceived "types" and explores the role of medium and body in the proliferation of that image. I then consider the current

iterations of Anniversary System Gregg Shorthand in contemporary digital culture and fine art, referencing biogs, social media sites, ecommerce sites, programs and the work of Tony Lewis. Through this exploration of the Anniversary System Gregg stenographic image, I seek to create a compelling case for historians to revisit the overlooked role of the image in shorthand histories. Though it may seem that the time to evaluate and understand stenographic systems has passed, these systems provide great insight into how image, language and the body work in concert. Gregg Shorthand provides an excellent specimen to study as it is highly informed by earlier stenographic systems and has, due to its speedy success in the United States, influenced the development of systems moving forward. Winner of the 2007 Jay L. Halio prize for best manuscript in Shakespeare studies, Shakespeare in Shorthand demonstrates that many textual anomalies derive from the play's transcription in Elizabethan shorthand. The shorthand system of John Willis, Stenographie (1602), shows a high correlation with the unusual textual features found in the first quarto of Lear (1608). The patterns of variants in the quarto conform to Willis' rules regarding the reduction of diphthongs and digraphs and the omission of aspirated, doubled, or unsounded letters. In the past two decades the textual interrelation of quarto and folio (1623) Lear has proven one of the most contested issues in Shakespearean studies, and an examination of Stenographie reveals that some of these textual differences result not from authorial revision, but from transmission in abbreviated writing. Bibliographical evidence also indicates that some textual omissions from the folio version are neither authorial nor theatrical, but derive from the printing house.
