Equipment such as ultrasound and lasers, and fiber-optic endoscopic equipment aid in these procedures. Some of the

subspecialties of urology are urologic oncology, endourology, reconstructive urologic surgery, pediatric urologic surgery, etc. This book unravels the recent studies in the field of urology. Also included herein is a detailed explanation of the various concepts and applications of urology. A number of latest researches have been included to keep the readers up-to-date with the global concepts in this area of study. Glenn's Urologic Surgery is a comprehensive but concise textbook focused on surgical procedures.
