According to infection control guidelines regarding the administration of intravenous medications, a fifteen second alcohol scrub to the injection port must be performed before the infusion of medication (JCAH, 2013). Unfortunately, this is not occurring, and as a result, bacteria on the port is injected into the patient's bloodstream (DeVries, 2014). Along with the Affordable Care Act, reimbursement from Medicare and Medicaid will not be given to any hospital or facility involving the development of a CLABSI, thus adding a financial burden. A typical CLABSI costs between \$6,000-22,000 (VDH, 2014). Research has devoted

much time and effort into the prevention of CLABSI resulting in the introduction of alcohol impregnated caps being applied to all central line injection ports in the aid in of providing continuous disinfection by preventing bacteria from harboring on the port and then being injected into the patient's bloodstream resulting in infection (Berenholtz, 2014).
