*Adoniram Judson was not only a historic figurehead in the first wave of foreign missionaries from the United States and a hero in his own day, but his story still wins the admiration of Christians even today. And he answered thus: "A supreme desire to please him is the grand motive that should animate Christians in their missionary efforts." Jesus knew that, so he spent time with his young disciples, talking with them, listening to them, having fun with them— being with them in everyday life.
