of Business Process Modeling (BPM) in the field of contracts management. Government defense contractors are heavily burdened by contracts which have ended, but have not been finalized and closed. In order to keep good relations with organizations regulating government contracts, contractors have been forced to devise a strategy to address contract closeouts. Through utilization of BPM practices, an organization is able to not only model the flow of their contract closeout process, but simulate the performance of their process under varying conditions so that goals and deadlines may be met. Data was collected about a defense contractors contract closeout process, and a simulation model was created to mimic the behavior of the system over the time to complete the contract closeout process. Various levels of resources were used in simulating the process to test the performance and throughput of the system. Using simulation software, the closeout process was able to be successfully modeled under varying resource levels. The simulation models included true worker process times with integrated schedules, including holidays, over the expected period of performance. The simulation produced a realistic model which allows an organization to plan their resources

to accomplish their contract closeout process under specified conditions and deadlines. This work also provides a base for further studies involving BPM and the field of contracts management. Illus. This is a print on demand report. In tapered closeouts designs, the sandwich laminate is transitioned to a solid laminate, with high compressive strength, by eliminating the core. Tapered closeouts are found to be prone to fatigue failure by delamination. The delaminations initiate at the region where the upper and lower facesheet meet to form a solid laminate, due to the presence of voids or resin rich areas. These cracks then grow along the facesheet-core interfaces and lead to fatigue failure by delamination. Improving the fatigue

life of sandwich closeouts requires a better understanding of the stresses and the damage growth mechanisms. The goal of this study is to elucidate the deformation mechanisms, load transfer, and interface stresses in the tapered close out section of a sandwich. The investigation of sandwich closeouts were performed using finite element analyses (FEA). The effects of geometry and facesheet to core stiffness on the deformation and stresses in the closeout regions are presented. The symmetry of the taper geometry and the interaction of the facesheet and core local deformation at the closeout regions are shown to provide anisotropic shear-bending coupling and shear-extension coupling. Large facesheet-core interfacial shear and normal stresses arise at the closeout region due to the localized bending at this region. The preliminary investigations also showed that the gradient in the geometry of the core leads to gradients in deformation and stress in the region. To compensate for stiffness reduction in the core geometry, use of functionally graded material (FGM) for the cores at the closeout locations are investigated. FGM cores with various gradations in the elastic modulus of the core along the closeout region were analyzed. The

results indicate that increasing the core modulus at the tapered closeout apex region is effective in reducing the local deformations. However, these increases lead to small increases in stress. The increase in stress in the FGM core is not a significant concern, because in FGMs increasing stiffness can also lead to increase in strength. Decreasing the core modulus at the closeout apex regions was found to be most effective in reducing the stresses. However, such a design has large localized deformations and reduced structural stiffness. The analyses indicate that a FGM material with decreasing inplane modulus, but increasing out of plane and shear modulus will be an optimum choice for the core material at the closeout location. GRANTS MANAGEMENT: Action Needed to Improve the Timeliness of Grant Closeouts by Federal Agencies The purpose of this joint applied project was to investigate and provide a comprehensive overview of current cross-organizational contract closeout practices. The goal of this project was to identify, compare, and document methods utilized and determine whether or not Regional Contracting Office-Hawaii (RCO-HI) may leverage established best practices. To

mitigate the current problem of excessive overaged Army contracts, the following questions were asked: 1. Are other local contracting offices leveraging best practices to meet Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) contract closeout timelines? 2. If so, can RCO-HI benefit by incorporating those best practices into the current closeout process? 3. What improvements, if any, are necessary to improve RCO-HI's closeout process?

Information was gathered through survey questionnaires targeted to acquisition professionals. In addition, a literary review provided potential best practices and tools capable of improving RCO-HI's current closeout process. This research project is an additional resource in the continued effort by RCO-HI to improve processes and reduce risks associated with overaged contracts.
