A prevalência da fibrose foi menor quando definida por biomarcadores (20%) do que aquela definida pela EHT. Pudemos concluir que 4% dos indivíduos infectados pelo HIV apresentam coinfeção pelo HCV e que 67% dos pacientes coinfectados pelo HIV-HCV apresentam fibrose hepática significativa pela EHT.
