social science supply and demand curve in economics crossing over at the optimal equilibrium social science is the study of human behavior and functioning of societies it has many disciplines that include but are not limited to anthropology economics history human geography political science psychology and sociology 1 a branch of science that deals with the institutions and functioning of human society and with the interpersonal relationships of individuals as members of society 2 a science such as economics or political science dealing with a particular phase or aspect of human society social scientist noun example sentences what is a social science major a social science major is typically part of a liberal arts education which encompasses the humanities social sciences and natural sciences natural science can be divided into two main branches physical science and life science or biology social sciences the study of human behavior in its social and cultural aspects scientific knowledge must be based on observable phenomena and must be capable of being verified by other researchers working under the same conditions anthropology is the study of human experience and social change through situated and relational methods anthropology considers the ways people think act and make sense of their lifeworlds against the backdrop of multiple structural forces and across intersecting domains and scales since the mid 20th century the term social science has come to refer more generally not just to sociology but to all those disciplines which analyze society and culture from anthropology to psychology to media studies a unique benefit of the social science degree program is that you are not tied to one specific social science discipline instead our curriculum is designed to allow you to choose courses from a variety of social science areas including anthropology psychology business economics criminal justice administration or sociology sociology a social science that studies human societies their interactions and the processes that preserve and change them it does this by examining the dynamics of constituent parts of societies such as institutions communities populations and gender racial or age groups sociology social science differs from natural science in that it examines the human constructed world rather than the physical world fields like biology chemistry and physics use the scientific method to propose hypotheses and theories social scientists rely on similar methods such as quantitative data analysis to study society social sciences ss is a category of academic fields concerned with society and social interactions it cuts across several academic disciplines including geography economics political science sociology psychology and even social medicine social science social science articles from across nature portfolio atom rss feed featured with some knowledge comes great confidence and negative attitudes toward science we proposed a what is social science the social sciences are as varied as the interests of humankind but they share a fascination with human behavior and organizations from the beginning of
