Some neurobiological phenomena are species-specific and diverse, especially in the domain of the neuronal control of locomotion and camouflage. Thus, separate chapters are provided on the control of swimming in annelids, crustacea and molluscs, locomotion in hexapods, and camouflage in cephalopods.
