Finally, in order to better understand how the wave function parameters relate to the formant parameters, mappings are developed between the wave function parameters and estimates of the formant parameters. It is shown that for either wide or narrow formant separations, reasonably accurate estimations of formant frequencies and bandwidths can be made. It is hoped that the detailed discussion and documentation of the algorithms will assist an informed evaluation of the appropriateness of the approach for various applied problems in speech processing.
