Afonso Costa Feb 02 2022 Portugal's poor military performance in the First World War, notably in Africa, restricted Afonso Costa's (1871-1937) ability to secure his diplomatic aims which, in any case, were highly unrealistic. These farming communities--Fairview, Paularino, and Harper--attracted families and businesspeople.
